



# Phlebotomy Booking System Guide

# For Haematology patients only

In response to patient feedback we're developing a booking system for patients who require regular blood tests. This service will be rolled out in a limited way initially with patients under the care of the Haematology team and having treatment at Maidstone being the first group to benefit from this service. Time slots will initially be limited but will increase as the service becomes established. Your clinical team will have let you know that you can use this service, it isn't suitable for all of our patients currently so we respectfully ask that you don't share details of the service with other patients at this time. The first time you use the service you'll need to register and create an account, the registration process should only take around 5minutes, you'll need a number of personal details to complete the process including your NHS number (this is a 10-digit number that you should be able to find on your hospital appointment letters).

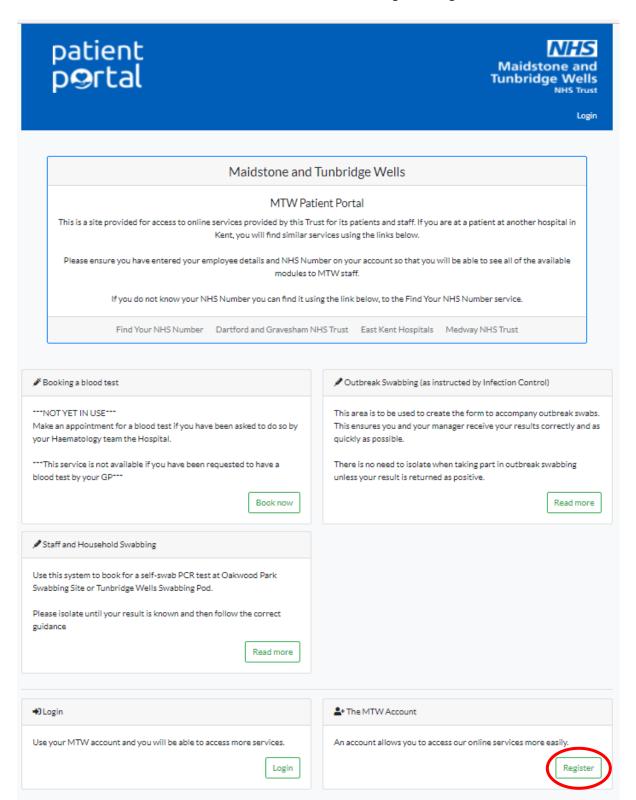

#### **Registration**

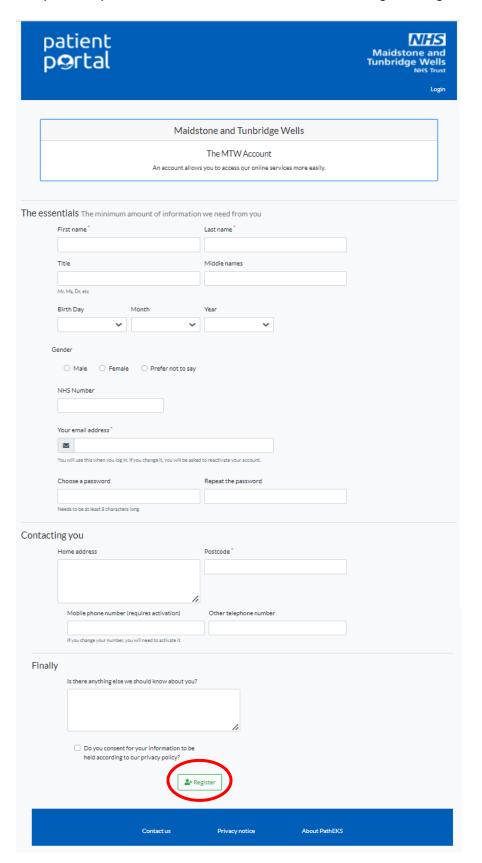
Step One:

Open <a href="https://mtw.healthit.org.uk/patheks">https://mtw.healthit.org.uk/patheks</a> in your web browser and fine the box towards the bottom of the screen named 'The MTW Account'. Click on the green 'Register' box.



### Step two:

Complete the personal details on the screen and click on the green 'Register' box.



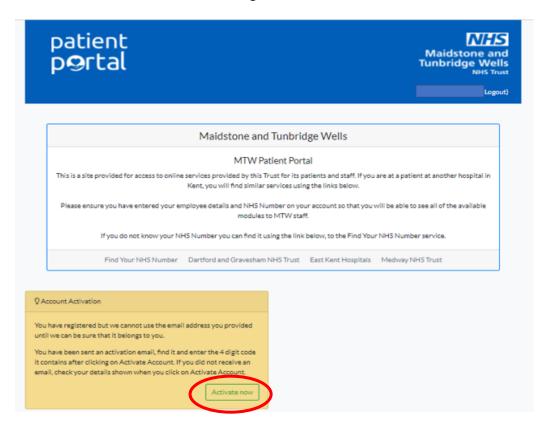
## Step three:

Under 'Account type' choose Haematology Oncology and scroll to the bottom of the page and click on the green 'Confirm account type' box.

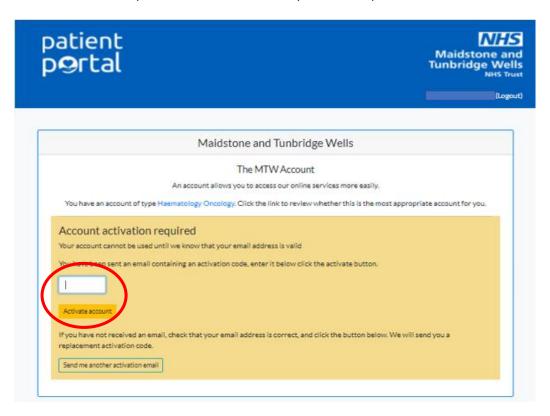
#### Step four:

Under 'Account Activation' click on the green 'Activate now' box.



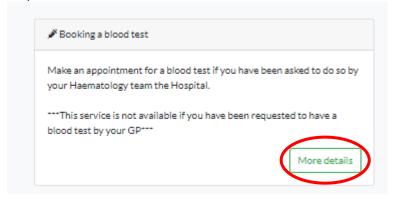
### Step five:

Check your email and add the code which has been sent to you to the code box followed by 'Activate account'. The same process is used to activate your mobile phone.



### Step six:

You will then be directed back to the front screen which should appear with a box called 'Booking a blood test'. Please be advised that all other sections of the page including swabbing are for staff only and therefore should not be accessed.



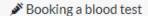
This completes the registration process. You can then log on each time you need to make a blood appointment.

### **Booking your blood test**

Step one:

Read all the information on this screen every time you make a booking as this is ill hold up to date information about the booking process.

Then scroll down and click on the green 'Book your test' box.

Once you've booked your appointment you'll receive a confirmatory text or email to the mobile 'phone number or email address that you provided in the registration process with the date and time of your appointment.

### What if I need to change my appointment?

Within the confirmatory message that you receive there is the facility to reschedule or cancel your appointment. If you're unable to attend please reschedule or cancel as soon as possible as this will enable us to offer the appointment to other patients.

### What will happen when I arrive?

On arrival please enter through the Oncology Centre entrance, we continue to try and minimise footfall in the department, please attend alone wherever possible and avoid arriving more than 15min prior to your appointment.

You may have taken a ticket on arrival previously, there's no need to do this now that you have a booked appointment.

# How will I know when it's my turn?

The phlebotomist will call your name when it's your turn, it's likely that booked appointments will take place in the 'Little Nightingale' initially. We'll be doing our best to keep to appointment times, if you're kept waiting for more than 20min past your appointment time please let the receptionist know.

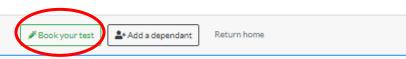

#### Coronavirus update

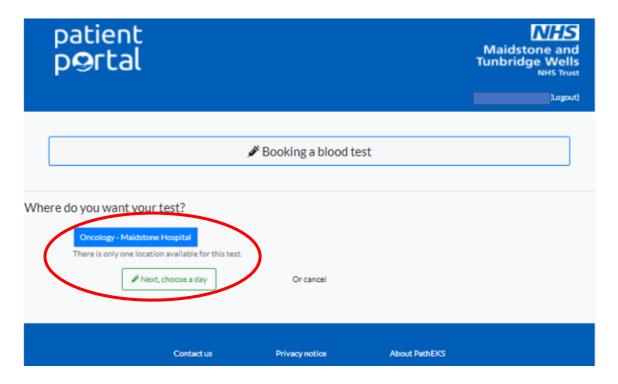
You will be issued with a mask upon arrival at our hospital sites and have your temperature taken. Please arrive alone where possible. No children will be permitted.

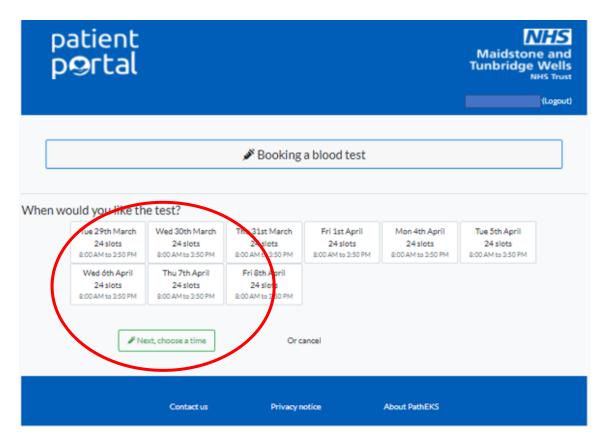
#### Step two:

Click on Oncology – Maidstone Hospital (this is the location of your blood test) and then click the green 'Next, choose a day' box.



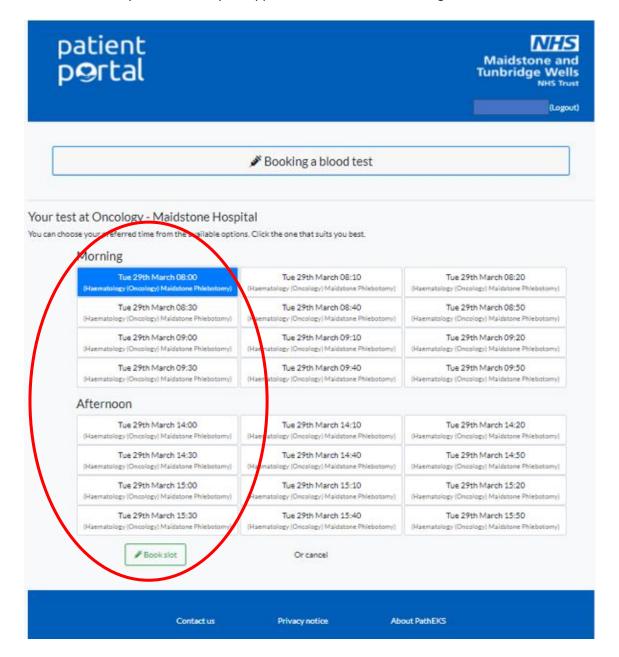
### Step three:

Click on the date you would like your appointment and then click the green 'Next, choose a time' box.



### Step four:

Click on the time you would like your appointment and then click the green 'Book slot' box.



#### Step five:

You will see your confirmation of booking on the next screen and an email will follow (you will also receive a text if you have activated your mobile). To return to the home screen click on the green 'Back to home page' box.



You can cancel and amend your appointment if needed via your email confirmation or by logging in to your account at any time and clicking on the green 'More details' box.
